Art competition

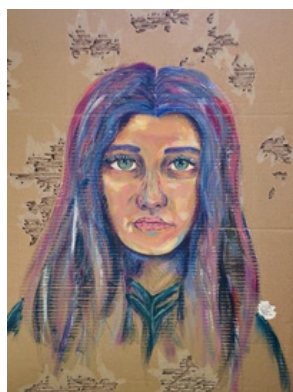
